## IN SHORT

Basics of Youth Work is a training course addressed to young youth workers who want to improve their abilities and learn more about non-formal education. The training will be held in Montebarro (Italy) not far from Milan and will last 6 days + 2 days of travel. Working together with youth workers from 7 European countries will allow the exchange of experiences and good practices and the creation of an international network of youth workers.

# • VENUE AND LOGISTICS



We will be staying in the Eco-Hostel Parco Monte Barro ([www.ostelloparcobarro.it](http://www.ostelloparcobarro.it)) on the top of Mount Barro, near Lecco and 50km from Milan.



Participants will be hosted on triple or quadruple room with private bathroom, towels and bed sheets.

They will be provided with 3-time buffet food and 2 coffee break per day.

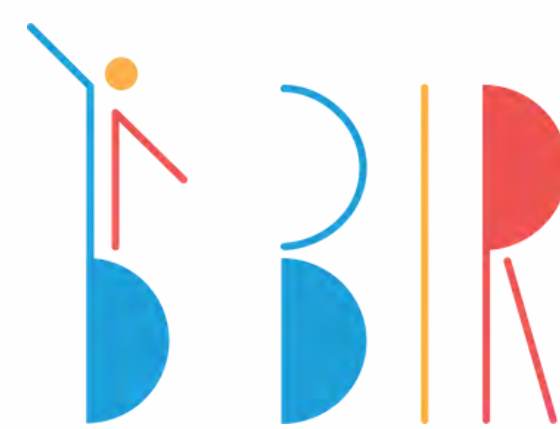
## TIPS ON WHAT TO BRING
