SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Length:** up to 4 pages, portrait orientation, margins of 2 cm on all sides, paragraph indent of 1 cm.
- **Font and spacing:** Times New Roman, 14 pt, 1.5 line spacing; for tables — Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1.0 line spacing; justified alignment; figures, tables, and diagrams are placed directly after the text where they are first mentioned. Each table must have a title placed above it. The title of illustrations is placed below them after the figure number. Page numbering and automatic hyphenation are not allowed.
- **List of references:** should be formatted in accordance with DSTU 8302:2015 and placed after the text of the abstract. Example of a reference citation: [7, p. 73-77; 3, p. 33].

All submitted abstracts will be checked for plagiarism.
