“LANGUAGE SKILLS: THE BRIDGE TO YOUR PROFESSIONAL FUTURE”

Following the presentations and discussions held during the Student Scientific Round Table “Language Skills: The Bridge to Your Professional Future”, the participants and language advisors reached the following conclusions and recommendations:

1. On the significance of language skills

1.1. Foreign language competence, particularly in English, is a key component of students' professional readiness across all fields of study.

1.2. Mastery of academic, professional, and digital communication skills significantly enhances graduates' competitiveness in the global labor market.

2. On integrating language learning with professional training

2.1. It is recommended to expand interdisciplinary connections between language courses and professional subjects (Philology, Psychology, IT, Management, Finance, Sports science, etc.).

2.2. Students should be encouraged to apply foreign languages in practical tasks: project work, research, presentations, and international collaboration.

3. On the development of digital and intercultural competencies

3.1. Participants emphasize the need to integrate AI tools, translation software, and digital platforms into language learning.

3.2. Intercultural communication skills are essential for effective interaction in multicultural environments, international cooperation, and academic mobility.

4. On fostering research and academic activity

4.1. The Round Table participants support the continuation of student scientific initiatives that promote research in linguistics, translation studies, communication, and applied language use.

4.2. It is recommended to encourage students to participate in conferences, publish research papers, and join international academic projects.

5. On professional growth and career development

5.1. Language skills should be promoted as a strategic investment in career advancement.

5.2. Students are encouraged to develop soft skills — presentation, negotiation, teamwork, and leadership — in combination with foreign language proficiency.

6. On further cooperation

6.1. Participants propose establishing regular student round tables, workshops, and thematic sessions on language and professional communication.

6.2. Strengthening cooperation with native speakers, international experts, and partner institutions is considered a priority.
